

STUDENTS

All students of Theatre De La DanSe must follow this **Code of Conduct** and are expected to show appropriate behaviour towards other students and teachers.

- > Be respectful towards teachers and staff through listening and following instruction.
- > Be kind to other students – we have a zero tolerance on bullying at Theatre De La DanSe.
- > Try your best to arrive to class on time.
- > Come wearing appropriate dancewear and your hair off your face or in a bun for girls in Ballet classes.
- > Please always ensure you were appropriate clothing and shoes when arriving and leaving the studio.
- > Students can not use mobile phones in class and are not permitted to film or photograph another student without their permission.
- > Students are not permitted to share video or photos of other students on social media without the permission of all students and the teacher –the choreography is the intellectual property of the teacher.
- > Create safe spaces for other students by not leaving bags and rubbish in common areas and walking between studios. Acro tricks are for studios only, not common walkways.
- > When representing Theatre De La DanSe outside of the studio, be respectful, encouraging and courteous to students and teachers from other schools.
- > Teachers and Staff at Theatre De La DanSe should always have your best interest in mind. If you feel like they don't, please talk to your parents or someone at TDLD that you feel comfortable with.

If any student has any concerns relating to yourself or another student, please talk to Miss Rachael or the staff member at reception and we will help you.

PARENTS

All parents with students attending Theatre De La DanSe are expected to follow this Code of Conduct. Any violations of the Code of Conduct may result in the termination of enrolment at Theatre De La DanSe.

- > Parents will advise Theatre De La Danse if their child has an injury and update teachers with reports from medical professionals.
- > Parents will respect the decision of a teacher to decide when a child should not be participating in a class, exam or performance due to an injury or other reason.
- > Parents will respect the decision that Teachers and the Principal make about the suitability of class levels for their child.
- > Theatre De La DanSe will not tolerate any bullying towards other parents, staff, teachers or students.
- > Photos and videos of children other than your own are not permitted unless given permission by the student or guardian.
- > Video or photos of other students are not to be shared on social media without the permission of all students involved and the teacher – the choreography is the intellectual property of the teacher.
- > Any solos choreographed by a teacher at TDLD remain the property of that teacher and cannot be used to represent another school.
- > Parents/Guardians are responsible for drop off and pick up of their child/ children from all classes.
- > TDLD is not responsible for students going between classes or for students who have a break between classes; parents/guardians are responsible for their child/ children going between classes or while on breaks between classes.
- > If any fees are not paid, Theatre De La DanSe reserve the right to suspend or withdraw a student from a class.
